What does it mean?

Who can become a Member?

- Any individual over the age of 16 living in the Strathglass Community Council area.
- Any group based in the Strathglass Community Council area.

Associate Members

- Any individual or group not living or working in the Strathglass Community Council area but with an interest in the work of SACC.
- Associate Members have no voting rights.

Who cannot become a Member?

- Employees of SACC are not eligible for membership.
